# SCENIC HIGHLIGHTS

---

**Glaciers, waterfalls, fjords, islands, the coast and the sea – there are countless natural attractions waiting for you in Nordfjord! In the inner part of Nordfjord, you come into close contact with wild, dramatic scenery with steep mountains and glaciers, while the ocean's edge awaits you on the coast. The contrasts are great, and you are guaranteed many unforgettable experiences!**

## **Blue glaciers and green valleys**

At 487 square kilometres, Jostedalbreen is the largest glacier in mainland Europe. The area is a unique part of Norway's natural environment and invaluable in terms of outdoor pursuits and nature experiences. It was therefore protected through the establishment of Jostedalbreen National Park. Here you find an unusually rich concentration of different landscapes and life forms, and much of the area is unspoilt or very little affected by human activity. Up on the glacier plateau, the glacier seems calm, but down towards the low-lying areas, the glacier arms hang like frozen waterfalls that drop more than a thousand metres. Measurements have shown that the glacier moves up to 1.5 metres a day, and large avalanches occur regularly on the steep sides of the glacier. Jostedalbreen is a typical plateau glacier surrounded by valley glaciers. The best known glacier arms in Nordfjord are the Briksdalsbreen, Kjenndalsbreen, Bødalsbreen and Brenndalsbreen glaciers.

Please note! Show respect for the forces of nature and keep your distance from the glacier. Glaciers are in constant movement, and the risk of avalanches is high.

## **Briksdalsbreen and Brenndalsbreen glaciers**

The most famous attraction in Stryn is the Briksdalsbreen glacier. Visitors from around the world visit this beautiful glacier arm, which is located between cascading waterfalls and tall mountain summits. Briksdalsbreen is situated at the head of the beautiful Oldedalen valley, approximately 20 km from the village of Olden. There is a three-kilometre gravel road from the mountain lodge to the glacier itself. You can either walk up or be driven in open vehicles. Briksdalsbreen Mountain Lodge is open from March to November. Activities, restaurant and a big souvenir shop (ad.p.40). There is a bus service to the Briksdalsbreen glacier during the peak season (ad.p.3). Brenndalsbreen glacier is situated in the Brenndalen valley, a tributary valley of Oldedalen. It offers breathtaking, spectacular scenery, surrounded by steep mountains. Glacier walks are available for part of the summer.

## **Lodalen valley, Kjenndalsbreen and Bødalsbreen glaciers**

The Kjenndalsbreen glacier is located innermost in the Lodalen valley, 17 km from the village of Loen. It is the lowest-lying glacier arm of Jostedalbreen. Fifteen-minute walk. Its stunning scen-

ery and dramatic history make the Lodalen valley quite unique. Enormous boulders have twice broken off Mount Ramnefjell and fallen into the Lovatnet lake, creating tidal waves that destroyed the hamlets of Nesdal and Bødal killing 135 people. The years 1905 and 1936 will always remind the people of inner Nordfjord of the Lodalen disasters. Memorial stones near Loen church and in the Lodalen valley commemorate those who lost their lives in the disasters. At the end of the Lovatnet lake, you find Kjenndalstova café. Bødalssetra summer pasture farm, 16 km from Loen, is the starting point for walks on the Bødalsbreen glacier.

## **Hornindalsvatnet lake**

all of 514 metres deep, Hornindalsvatnet is Europe's deepest lake. No glacier rivers flow into the lake, making it particularly clear and blue. Rumour has it that there is a sea serpent in the lake, but this has yet to be confirmed ... If you want to run right round the lake, you can take part in Hornindalsvatnet International Marathon, which is held in July every year.

## **The Kannesteinen rock**

kannesteinen is a rock with a strange stem-like shape that stands on the shore in the village of Oppedal, 10 km west of the centre of Måløy. For thousands of years, the ocean has pounded and ground down the Kannesteinen rock, creating its unique shape. The rock is about 4-5 metres high. It is a popular subject for photographers and a symbol of Vågsøy municipality. The Tamil action film Maattrraan used it as a location in summer 2012.

## **West Cape (496 m)**

West Cape is the westernmost viewpoint on mainland Norway. West Cape is an impressive experience, with the Sunnmøre alps in the distance as a prelude to the powerful symphony of the sea below. The cliff plunges steeply into the ocean. When the weather is good, you can enjoy jaw-dropping panoramic views in all directions. Excellent views of the Sunnmøre alps, Mount Hornelen, the Ålfotbreen glacier and the stormy Stadhavet sea.

## **Storm at Stad**

'Storm at Stad' is a well-known phrase from Norwegian weather forecasts. Nowhere else in the country are there hurricane force winds or full storms more often than off the Stadlandet coast. It is a powerful sight to see the wind whipping up the sea and the waves crashing high above the cliffs along the coast. Experiencing a storm can be a fantastic experience, but remember that there are huge forces at work, so make sure to stand somewhere safe. There have been many dramatic events along the coast throughout the years. Join a guided tour with Stadt Naturguiding, and learn more about the coastal culture and history.

## HIKING – Fjord Hiking 365

In the magnificent, varied scenery of Nordfjord, you can walk between the fjord, the sea, mountains and glaciers. The mountains of Nordfjord rise straight up from the fjord to heights of more than 2,000 metres. Take a walk in the inner part of Nordfjord with its tall peaks and narrow valleys, the middle part of Nordfjord with its more open landscape and rounded summits, or to outer Nordfjord with its characteristic coastal landscape. The mild coastal climate means there are opportunities for walking all year round.

There are more than 230 waymarked paths in Nordfjord that take you to mountain peaks, glaciers, deep valleys, old summer pasture farms, waterfalls and rivers. The paths vary from family-friendly short walks to long, demanding all-day walks.

### Summits

There are impressive mountain summits everywhere in the Nordfjord area. They offer fantastic views of the fjord landscape. Some of the walks are long and require you to be in good physical shape, while others are easily accessible and more suitable for family walks.

Some recommended walks:

❶ **Skåla** (1,848 m), known as Norway's longest uphill slope. At the top is the distinctive Skåla tower, built in 1891, now a self-service cabin that sleeps 22 run by the Norwegian Trekking Association (DNT).

❷ **Hornindalsrokken** (1,529 m), a jagged peak that is a landmark on the border between Nordfjord and the Sunnmøre region.

❸ **Eggenipa** (1,338 m), a 'postcard mountain' in Gloppen with a distinctive profile.

❹ **Trollenyken**, (898 m) an easy but steep walk from Nordfjord-deid to panoramic views up on the top.

❺ **Veten** (613 m), Måløy's 'town mountain' with views of the sea.

❻ **Hornelen** (890 m), the highest sea cliff in Northern Europe, which plunges straight into the Nordfjord.

Each of these walks is guaranteed to provide a magical experience – either on high summits that will take your breath away, along the exotic coast or on historic roads. Taken together, these walks represent the diversity and the very best walks in Nordfjord. You get to combine spectacular nature experiences with history, culture, fauna and flora. Nordfjord is a bit of Norway in miniature. It has both white sandy beaches and high alpine mountains surrounded by glaciers.

### Nature and culture trails

❼ **Nature trails in Jostedalbreen National Park.** Ten nature trails in the inner part of Nordfjord, with separate information booklets. Each trail teaches you about the local flora and fauna, glaciers, salmon fishing, the historical landscape and old highways and byways. The booklets can be purchased at the Tourist Information Office in Stryn.

**8** Culture trail at Ulvedal, Stryn. Circular walk of about 2.5 km through gentle woodland that includes many of the cultural history attractions in Ulvedal.

**9** Culture trails in Randabygda, Stryn. Rand school/Bakkesvandet – Tvinnefossen waterfall (25 min.). Circular walk. Hammerstunet – Tvinna (60-70 min.), Hammerstunet – Tvinnekråa (20 min.). Information boards at each attraction.

**10** Historical walk in Bødal, Lodalen, Stryn. Path between the farms that were struck by the tidal wave following the rockslides from Mount Ramnefjell in 1905 and 1936. Separate information booklet.

**11** The North Sea Trail, Vågsøy. Marked walking trail from Vågsberget to the Kannesteinen rock, part of the North Sea Trail. Contact Vågsberget for more information. Tel. +47 905 45 029

**12** Trondheim Post Road. Part of the historic Trondheim Post Road passes through the inner part of Nordfjord. Follow the restored sections from Utvik, over the fjord to Faleide, on to Markane, across Kjøsahalsen hill to Grodås in the centre of Hornindal. The road was the first land connection between Bergen and Trondheim.

### Mountain farm visits

The summer pasture farms in Nordfjord are both attractive destinations and unique cultural heritage sites. Running summer pasture farms is a long-standing tradition in Norway. The farmers started using summer pastures because of a lack of grazing around their farms, which meant that they had to use outlying grazing further afield. Not many of the summer pasture farms are in use today, but the small farmhouses are often well preserved,

and the pastures are a unique cultural landscape and a reminder of the days when summer pasture farms were common. **13** At Gjengedalsstølen in Hyen, there is still an active summer pasture farm that produces milk. Boat hire and the traditional 'rømmeask' (a local sour cream speciality) available on request, tel. +47 917 20 950. Summer pasture farm with lots of goats at **14** Myklandsstølen in Kandal in Gloppen municipality. Tel. +47 57 86 75 26. In the Erdalen valley in Stryn, you can visit **15** Vetledalsetra summer pasture farm where Indre Nordfjord trekking association runs a self-service cabin. Right at the edge of the lake in the Lodalen valley, you pass **16** Breng summer pasture farm, a photographers' favourite with its green lake, steep mountainsides and the glacier arms innermost in the valley. These are just a few examples – you will find summer pasture farms in all the valleys in Nordfjord. You can drive all the way (usually on a toll road) to some of them, others you have to walk to. Take your lunch break in a rural idyll, in a cultural landscape rich in tradition and history, and dream of a time of dairy maids, hard toil but also fiddle players, dancing and fun.

### Glacier walks

Experience the blue ice up close on a guided glacier walk. A magical adventure you simply have to try. The glaciers consist of ice that is in constant movement. Show respect for the forces of nature! If you know too little about glaciers yourself, there are many experienced glacier guides ready to take you on a walk on the ice. ## Maps and marked walking trails

More and more walking trails in Nordfjord are marked according to national standards (level of difficulty: green, blue, red and black). Two networks of trails are also marked: **17** Harpefossen (Eid) and **18** Turløyper Stryn. In addition to maps covering the whole country, good walking maps are available for the Stryn,

Eid and Gloppen areas. The maps have marked trails and text describing each walk. The walks vary in length and degree of difficulty. The maps can be purchased at the tourist information offices in Nordfjord.

## OUTDOOR ADVENTURES

---

**In Nordfjord, you will find your own natural playground. If you have planned a week's holiday, you will change it to two when you see the range of activities you can choose from. Imagine gliding across a quiet, clear lake in a kayak, throwing your fishing line into the sea, cycling between fjords, mountains and glaciers, or maybe getting your adrenaline pumping with some rafting, a via ferrata, off-road biking or a helicopter ride. All this and more is available in Nordfjord. Visit the websites to find more information and let the images inspire you. Also remember that you will find a complete list of activity enterprises with email addresses and phone numbers at the back of this guide.**

### Surfing

At Stad, you will find perfect surfing conditions, with big waves and white sandy beaches, and with steep mountainsides creating a perfect backdrop. Maybe the word surfing sets you thinking about palm trees and tropical temperatures in southern climes. Surfing in the beautiful coastal landscape at Stad is at least as exotic. These fantastic beaches have long been hidden surfing gems, but more and more people have now discovered the joy of surfing out here at the ocean's edge. The kilometre-long sandy beach at **1** Hoddevik is one of Norway's best and most beautiful surfing spots. Thirty kilometres away is **2** Ervikstranda beach, where there are almost always waves. Be aware of undercurrents and the remains of shipwrecks in Ervik.

### Cycling

In Nordfjord, you can cycle on old carriage roads with hardly any traffic, on roads that wind their way up valleys, or alongside the ocean under the red evening sun. The roads through this contrasting landscape are suitable for families, but we also have suggestions for those who like more challenging terrain, either on trails in the mountain or forest roads up to summer pasture farms.

#### Recommended trip: Hellesylt–Vollset–Flofjellet–Flo–Stryn

From Hellesylt, you cycle towards Vollset, where you take the road over **5** Flofjellet mountain, and down to the charming, fruit-growing village of Flo. You then cycle along Oppstrynsvatnet lake and continue on the RV 15 road towards Stryn. The cycling is relatively easy. There are some uphill sections from Hellesylt to Vollset, but the cycling track is good. Flofjellet mountain offers wonderful scenery, with roaring waterfalls and peaceful lakes. You will also pass several idyllic summer pasture farms. The trip takes four to six hours and is about 40 km long. The highest point is 550 m. Want to cycle this route with a guide? **7** Downhill cycling. Harpefossen Ski Centre has downhill bikes for hire. Take the ski lift at Furuhogane to the start of the downhill track. Jumps, drops, slopes and bridges mean great challenges for daring and experienced cyclists. The total length of the downhill track is 1,000 metres.

### Recreational cycling.

**8** Harpefossen is also a good starting point for cycling trips on a varied network of roads and paths. A great 8-km circular route that passes four summer pasture farms. You can also cycle the old Postal Road in idyllic surroundings from Harpefossen to Bjørkedalen and back, a total distance of 20 km. Season from May to October. Nordfjord. Nowadays, it is used for riding, drawing carts and buggies and other leisure activities. The fjord horse is like the people of Nordfjord: hard-working, good-natured and reliable. Seeing the landscape on horseback is a fantastic experience that you simply have to try!

### Bathing on white sandy beaches

## CULTURE

Nordfjord has a rich and diverse cultural scene, with long-standing traditions in folk music, visual art, and arts and crafts. You will find unique cultural heritage sites such as Selje Monastery and the Viking graves at Nordfjordeid. At the same time, you will also find a very active, modern cultural scene, including highlights such as Opera Nordfjord, Malakoff Rock Festival and the Norwegian Country Festival.

### Selje Monastery

On the island of Selja, 15 minutes by boat from Selje, lie the ruins of ❶ Selje Monastery. The monastery tower is intact. The monastery was built by Benedictine monks in the early 12th century. The legend of Saint Sunniva, who died a martyr's death here, lives on. Legend has it that Sunniva, the daughter of an Irish King, fled when Ireland was conquered by pagans and the new king wanted to marry her. She arrived on the island of Selja. St Sunniva cave is where Sunniva died, according to legend. Several Viking graves and the remains of a longhouse from the Iron Age have also been discovered on the island. Marked pilgrimage path from Bø to Selje Monastery. Tel. +47 57 85 66 06. Ad.p. 31.

Please note! Camping is prohibited in the monastery area. Guided tours by boat from the centre of Selje during summer.

### In search of the Vikings

Many archaeological finds from the Viking era have been made in Nordfjord. Here are a few examples. For more detailed information, go to [www.nordfjordhistorie.no](http://www.nordfjordhistorie.no).

The Myklebust ship, Nordfjordeid. In the burial mounds at Myklebust, traces have been found of a 25-metre-long ship, which makes it the biggest Viking ship ever found in Norway. ❷ Information boards in Eidsgata.

Karnilshaugen, Sandane. The biggest burial mound in Western Norway.

Female grave at Sandal in Myklebustdalen valley, Gloppen. Finds include amethyst from the Middle East, parts of a Frankish funnel-shaped glass and a bronze clasp that probably comes from an Irish reliquary.

Grave and stone cross in Loen. An unburned female grave from the early Iron Age. A Celtic stone cross in the churchyard.

Dragseidet, Selje. When the weather was too poor for the Vikings to sail around the Stad peninsula, they hauled their boats across the 240-metre high Dragseidet. On the King's mound on top of the isthmus, Olav Tryggvasson converted four counties to Christianity in 997.

Burial mounds in Refvik, Vågsøy. Several burial mounds from the late Iron Age. An unburned male grave from the Viking era.

Runestone on the island of Barmen, Selje. Runes were used as a written language from the start of the Christian era.

### Opera, rock and country

#### 4 Jostedalsbreen National Park Centre, Oppstryn, Stryn.

Museum with film, exhibitions and a unique wild-flower garden. Film screened in a separate cinema auditorium. Exhibitions of landscape models, collection of minerals and a geological park, with the county stones from all the Norwegian counties. Authorised National Park Centre. Ad. p. 30.

**5 Nordfjord Folkemuseum, Sandane, Gloppen.** The museum has 45 preserved buildings of which many are furnished in the manner from when they were still in use. Most of the buildings date from the 17- 1800 c. There is a permanent cultural-historical exhibition and also guest exhibitions. Simple café. The 60 foot long sea vessel, Holvikjekta, is the last of the traditional passenger/ freight boats that sailed the coastline and fjord in the previous century. It is located outside of the town centre on main road E-39. Information board on site. Ad. p. 30.

**6 Anders Svor Museum, Hornindal.** The renowned sculptor Anders Svor (1864–1929) has his own museum in his home village of Hornindal. There, you can admire most of his production, 450 sculptures in all.

**7 Singerheimen, Olden, Stryn.** William Henry Singer (1868-1943) from Pittsburg USA, lived and worked in Singerheimen. They are buried in a private chapel beside the studio. Singer was a man of the world and an impressionist artist and in Olden he was the painter of «peace and atmosphere». In the studio you will see some of his finest works of art. Ad.p. 30

**8 The farm museum at Nedrebergtunet, Stryn.** Farm museum with a unique exhibition featuring the life of women on a 19th century farm. The exhibits include many textiles, about 80 woven wall-hangings/rugs, bed linen and clothing, tableware and everyday articles made of wood. Most of the items come from the farm and belonged to the Nedreberg family. Tel. +47 480 38 007.

**9 Galleri Myr, Stryn.** Art gallery in the centre of Stryn. The gallery opened in 2011 with the goal of creating an arena where artists from the region and others could exhibit their work locally.

**10 Orheimstunet, Stårheim, Eid.** Private collection in memory of the blind author and Preacher Matias Orheim. Tel +47 57 86 22 92.

**11 Old Bank Culture Centre, Eid.** Here, you can see and buy art by many different artists. Regular concerts by the pupils of the culture school. Tourist Information Office. The building dates from 1881.

**12 Galleri Salen in Doktorgarden** culture centre. Gallery in the centre of Selje. Open during summer.

**13 Vågsberget trading station, Vågsøy.** Old Inn and Trading Station from 1636, when licensed tradesman Didrik Fester came from Bergen to Vågsberget to trade. The trading and the inn probably existed even before Fester came, and the trading station at Vågsberget has changed owners several times through its history. Open during the summer season with café, art exhibition and guided tours. Exhibition of old fishing boats and equipment. Under restoration. For opening hours call tel. +47 905 45 029 or contact the tourist information office.

**14** **Gallery Amdam** – The gallery by the ocean, Selje. 2 km from the centre of Selje. Kjell Stig Amdam. Tel +47 57 85 66 56.

**15** **Hagevik Tøndefabrik, Vågsøy.** A barrel-making factory that is more than a hundred years old. The only one in the country to be listed by the Directorate for Cultural Heritage in Norway. The factory produced barrels for salting fish during the boom years for the fisheries industry. Guided tours on request.

### Lighthouses

the lighthouses in Vågsøy are situated on steep reefs and crags, with the roaring sea as the nearest neighbour. They were built there to guide ships safely to the harbour. The lighthouses have been well looked after and are now popular tourist destinations.

**19** **Kråkenes - The Storm lighthouse** Beautiful view towards Stadhavet, the westernmost sea of Norway. Road access. The lighthouse lies on the northern-most and most exposed spot on the island. Standing a safe distance from the waves on a stormy day, studying the sea is a fantastic experience. Accommodation. Ad. p. 37.

**20** **Ulvesund - The Culture lighthouse** Lies at Hjertnes on the mainland just above Raudeberg. County road to Osmundsvåg. Accommodation. Good parking. Easily accessible by road or by boat. Café, courses, culture. Ad. p. 37.

**21** **Skongenæs - The Walkers lighthouse** One hour walk from Halsør in easy hiking terrain. Beautiful view towards Stadhavet. Ytre Nordfjord Turlag, which is affiliated to the Norwegian Mountain touring Association (DNT), has the use of this lighthouse and it offers overnight accommodation and day visits. No road access. Ad. p. 37.

### War memorial

during the Second World War many events took place in Nordfjord, which are now mentioned in our history books. The most famous event is which took place on Boxing Day in 1941. Captain Martin Linge and his company attacked the German positions in Måløy, Vågsøy. The Måløy Raid actually influenced Hitler's military strategy later on. At Moldøen, there are still ruins of the canon positions used during World War II

At Sandsstøylen in Gloppen you will find **Russehol**a (The Russians' cave). Used as a hiding place for a group of Russians during the Second World War. A dramatic memorial from the war years.

**Eksersisplassen at Nordfjordeid** (locally referred to as "Plassen") was founded in 1649, as a military training ground for Eid and Hornindal, and is the oldest one in the country. In recent years Plassen has been freshened up, and is a pleasant park area. All the buildings from the end of the 18th century have been restored, and an amphitheatre has been built from natural stone, which seats around 500 people.

### Churches

**22** **Old Gimmestad Church, Sandane.** Built in 1692 and is a good example of Norwegian church architecture from the time after the Reformation. Around 1720 it was painted with a red base colour and decorated with flower motifs. The ceiling was painted blue and decorated with numerous stars. Information board on site. Guided tours Tuesday, Thursday and Friday in July. Time: 15 – 17. Price: Adults NOK 40. Children NOK 20. It is also possible to arrange tours outside of opening hours. Tel +47 911 07 329.

**23** **Vereide Church, Gloppen.** Roadside church, most certainly built in the 10th century. Information board on site. Art exhibition in the church for the most part of the summer. Open for guided tours in July. Free admission.

**24** **Loen Church, Loen, Stryn.** Built in 1837, but on the same spot there was previously a stave church dating back as early as 1360. There is a thousand-year Celtic stone cross by the church. This is one of the oldest Christian monuments in the country. The church is open all summer.

**25** **Olden Old Church, Olden.** The only crosschurch in Nordfjord, was built in 1759. Excavations under the floor, show that a stave church was once located in the same place, and coins, amongst other things, from the 13th century have been found. The old stave church was demolished in 1746, and a timber church was constructed. This church was destroyed during a heavy storm in 1757.

**26** **Eid Church, Nordfjordeid.** Built in 1849 and restored in 1915. The church is open from 10 am until 10 pm during the summer.

**27** **Stårheim Church, Eid.** From 1864. Just beside the church is a roughly cut stone monument of the Bagler bishop, Nikolaus Arneson, and in the churchyard there is a stone commemorating the blind psalmist Matias Orheim.

**28** **Kapellneset in Raudeberg.** This was where the first church on Vågsøy was built in 1580. This church was used until 1854, when a new, larger church was built at Røysa in Raudeberg. The bell tower at Kapellneset was built in 1944 in memory of this church site. The bells and stone door slabs have been preserved from the old church.

**29** **Ervik church, Selje.** Built in memory of the coastal steamer «St. Svithun» which sank here in 1943. Roadside church.

**30** **Selje church, Selje.** Inaugurated in 1866 and was, in its time, one of the largest country churches in the Bjørgvin diocese.

Some of the churches are open during summer. Contact the tourist information office for more information.

### Food pleasures

agriculture and fishing are part of the fabric of Nordfjord, and these industries still have a strong position in the region. This is manifested in the delicious meat and fish dishes, accompanied by the season's forest and mountain berries, and Norwegian fruit. Fish has a central place in the coastal municipalities. A modern fishing fleet and a well-developed fish farming industry go together with world-class processing and export businesses. For many years, the gravel road was the only connection between east and west, and the Norwegian Public Roads Administration has reerected the row of guard stones so that the tourists will feel as though they are travelling on the old road. Do not miss the amazing stone bridge Jol bridge, on your way up the mountain side. Along the national tourist road you'll also find a summer skiing centre, picnic areas and information boards. [www.turistveg.no](http://www.turistveg.no)

### The Panorama Road (RV 613)

The trip follows the northern side of the fjord through the communities of Blakset, Fjelli, Randabygd/Hopland, Hennebygda and Lote (38 km). Start 6 km from the centre of Stryn. The Panorama road has taken its name from the fantastic views it affords of the fjord. The altitude above sea level varies from 0–approx 550 m. Particular good viewpoints are at Nordsida church, Nos and Kvalen. On the route you can also take in the culture trails at Ulvedal and at Hammer – the Tvinnefoss waterfall, and other historic attractions.

## Interesting islands

On the island of Selja, a 15-minute boat ride from the village of Selje, lie the ruins of the 12th century Selje Monastery, one of the best preserved monastery ruins in Norway.

On the idyllic island of Silda, you can walk for hours on car-free roads, perhaps enjoy a swim, and finish off with a bite to eat and 'something on the side' at Skjærbuda restaurant.

The island of Barmen is situated between Selje and Flatraket. Here you can study historic sites, or enjoy some fishing in rivers and lakes that abound in fish. The scenery is magnificent, and the distinctive profile of the mountain is the origin of the name Barmen, which means 'bosom'. Marked walking trails. Many burial mounds and antiquities. Signs of settlement dating all the way back to the Stone Age. Rune-stone. Area for camper vans and tents.

## Rumbling waterfalls

**Tvinnefossen waterfall, Nordsida, Stryn.** Here you can walk behind the waterfall and see through the cascading waters. Nice view over the Nordfjord.

**Glomnesfossen waterfall, Hjelledalen, Stryn.** Near the path to Sigdestad, an old farm which lies 280 meters above Strynevatn lake.

**Buldfossen waterfall, Videseter, Stryn.** At the start of The Old Strynefjell mountain road. Here the waters thunder and roar as they dive to the valley below. NB! Parking fee.

**Øvstefoss waterfall** is located along the RV 15 road at the end of the Hjelledalen valley, about 300 metres before the turn off to Gamle Strynefjellsvegen road. Spectacular view of the magnificent waterfall and the narrow gully through which the river flows.

**Kleivafossen waterfall, Briksdalen, Stryn.** On the way to the Briksdal Glacier you will pass the Kleivafossen waterfall. One of the most photographed motifs in Norway is the horse and trap on the bridge with this waterfall in the background. Parking fee.

**Volefossen waterfall, Briksdalen, Stryn.** From the mountain lodge in Briksdalen, you can admire the 300-meter free-fall of Volefossen waterfall. Parking fee.

**Ramnefjellsfossen/Utigardsfossen, Lodalen, Stryn.** One of the most magnificent waterfalls in the world, placed 11th on the list of the world's highest waterfalls.

**Krunefossen waterfall** - Spectacular waterfall. Also on the list of the world's highest waterfalls.

**Eidsfossen waterfall, Sandane, Gloppen.** Here is one of the world's highest salmon stairs. Drive in there from main road E-39. Information board on the site.

**Holvikfossen waterfall, Sandane, Gloppen.** It is possible to walk up to the waterfall from Kleivedammen pound, or via the toll road from Fjellbygda.

**Sandalsfossen and Strupen (820 m), Myklebustdalen Valley, Gloppen.** Strupen is placed 10th on the list of the world's highest waterfalls. Under Mt. Snønipa (1827 m.a.s.) you will see this beautiful waterfall.

## The cruise ship port in Olden - Nordfjord

Olden is the most important cruise ship destination in the Nordfjord region, and one of the ten most visited cruise ports in Norway. Cruise ships are also welcome in Måløy, Selje, Nordfjordeid and Sandane. All the cruise ship destinations in Nordfjord offer a range of exciting attractions and excursions.

## SKI & WINTER – with fjord view

The scenery of Nordfjord is the most beautiful in Norway, and its majestic mountains and deep fjord are the perfect backdrop to winter experiences. At the coast, winters are often mild with little snow, while further inland it often snows, which means there are many days with powder snow. In Nordfjord, you will find world-class skiing terrain and great ski centres with prepared tracks set in the beautiful and spectacular scenery of Western Norway, often with great views of the fjord. A trip to Nordfjord can be spiced up with summit trips, surfing at Stad, spa and wellbeing treatments, and tasty meals prepared from local ingredients, or you can just enjoy the dramatic winter landscape of the fjords.

### Alpepass no - one ski pass - eighth ski centres

Alpepass is a joint ski lift pass that is valid for eighth selected destinations in Western Norway – two ski centres in Nordfjord and six in Sunnmøre. The pass gives you access to: 32 lifts, over 60 downhill slopes, 800-metres of altitude difference, terrain parks, freeskiing and lots of snow and fun. 


